Dear Ron,

Thank you for the opportunity to offer a breathtaking 7- night Alaska cruise as an optional addition to your Veteran's association reunion in Bellevue Washington.

As discussed, the correct date for this cruise would be Sunday July 31, 2011 departing from Seattle and returning Sunday August 7th 2011 to Seattle.

FYI the passenger ship terminal in Seattle is approximately 10 miles from the Hilton Bellevue hotel and transportation to the pier can be arranged easily. Also, transportation to the airport at the end of the cruise can be arranged as well.

For 2010 the comparable cruise will be on the spectacular Sapphire Princess and will be doing the following itinerary:

Since the cruise line does not have their 2011 itineraries or rates in place I can give you "approximate" rates for the different categories of staterooms.

Interior staterooms: \$975pp - \$999pp

Oceanview staterooms: \$1425pp - \$1449pp

Balcony staterooms \$1749pp - \$1799pp

These prices are estimated and based on double occupancy and include all taxes and govt. fees.

There could be additional amenities such as onboard credits and/or private cocktail parties and/or in room amenities that will be based on the current offers & the amount of passengers that will sail.



There will be a "tour conductor" award for every 8 double occupancy staterooms that sail. This award will be between \$550 - \$1250 and will depend upon the categories booked.

Also, when the offer goes out to the attendees we can do a special "cruise sale" with reduced deposits (\$100 pp) + and other amenities as an incentive to get organized.

Ron, I will have the exact information and offer approximately May / June of 2010. If you decide to go forward I would suggest we get organized as soon as possible so I can reserve enough staterooms and work on your amenities prior to the sailing become available to the general public.
